## **The Position**

Candidates must have a MD (board eligibility/ certification in Ophthalmology preferred) with at least 3 years of biotechnology/pharmaceutical industry experience- clinical/ research background in Ophthalmology will be a plus. Experience in managing clinical trial conduct is preferred.
